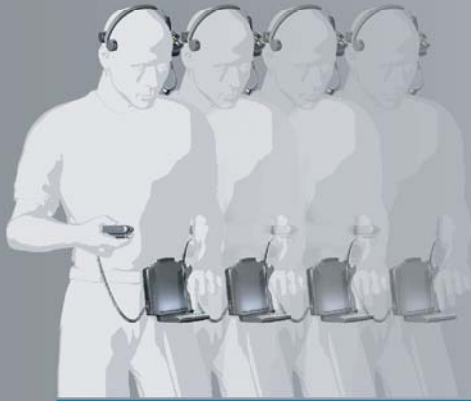

# Specifications



**Frontline Central** is a powerful software addition to the Frontline Communicator. It enables one central computer to manage communications with many Frontline Communicator units operating under different bandwidth conditions. Using Frontline Central, you may interact in real-time with a team of Frontline Communicator users dispersed throughout a plant or even anywhere around the world. By doing so, Frontline Central provides you with multiple points of view instantaneously thus facilitating and accelerating the review and assessment of any situation.

Frontline Central runs on an IP network. It is equipped with numerous call management features. For instance, you may choose the number of participants that can take part in the audio conversation, or save video images for future use.
